### March Report

Riparian restoration work, including final clearing and planting near Crooked Creek, continued on Bear Creek with South Medford seniors. Willow planting will continue on Cunningham Creek at Coquille in early April. Over 300 cuttings and one gallon plants are growing at our native plant project on Jamerry Farm. Ninety percent will be planted next fall and winter on Bear Creek.

Butte Falls: water color class and hike planned

Coquille: Hanging basket care by Believe You Can Achieve (BYCA) students. Willow planting in early February on Cunningham Cr.

Denman Wildlife Area: Trail maintenance on all 3 trails including Denman, Little Butte Cr., and Nick Young. Black Cottonwood cutting from a fallen cottonwood.

Gold Beach: BYCA kids worked on on-premise gardens, plus work at hatchery grounds and trail work on Rotary and Elephant Bar Tr.

Illinois Valley: Work on on-premise gardens and watered and mulched plants at E. Fork Illinois R. and Thompson Cr.

Kids Unlimited: Maintenance on Bear Creek project at Mahar Building.

Myrtle Point: Garden maintenance and orders for spring flowers.

Pacific: Work continued on Sixes Tr. and Elk River Hatchery plantings.

South Medford: A new group of seniors have continued to plants and mulch additional plants. They also assisted in trash pickup.
