May Report

Nineteen graduating seniors from six high schools have earned \$11,000 in scholarships for college or job training.

We have started our summer maintenance on trails, campus gardens, and riparian projects planted by students. This will be our last report until August when we will do a consolidated summer report.

Butte Falls: Field trip to view signs of spring, identifying plants, trees and native flowers.

Coquille: Work conducted on boardwalk and Cunningham Cr. plantings. Sold all hanging baskets from our greenhouse project. Profit was used to purchase fresh plants for campus gardens.

Denman Wildlife Area: Trail clearing on all 3 trails including Denman, Little Butte Cr., and Nick Young.

Gold Beach: Garden care on high school and elementary campuses. Maintenance of Hatchery, Elephant Bar and Rotary Trails.

Illinois Valley: Watered plants on Thompson Cr. and East Fork projects. Worked on campus native plant garden and cleared weeds and brush from Upper Grayback Trail. Students did a yard cleanup for community service.

Kids Unlimited: Riparian plant maintenance at Mahar Bldg.

Myrtle Point: Garden work at both high school and elementary schools. Laced several trees at high school.

Pacific: Trail clearing at Sixes River and Ironhead boat ramp.

South Medford: Maintenance continues on 3 ½ miles of restoration at Bear Creek.

Rogue Community College: Planted native plants on Bear Creek riparian area. Planted Oregon Ash trees and willow and osier dogwood cuttings.
