November Monthly Report

Salmon counts have been completed on Bear Creek and the Illinois River. Counts were strong in Bear Creek and fair in the Illinois River. Low water caused much of the spawning activity in lower stretches of each.

Maintenance continued on coastal and nearby trails. Riparian restoration continues each Saturday on a ½ mile stretch of Bear Creek.

Butte Falls: Elementary class created fall leaf collages from leaves collected at Butte Falls. They also planted daffodil bulbs.

Coquille: Still 95% survival on osier dogwood and willow cutting project last winter. Hanging basket care and preparation for winter plantings.

Denman Wildlife Area: Late fall maintenance on 5 miles of 3 trails. Trash pickup on all trails.

Gold Beach: Maintenance continued on Rotary and Elephant Bar Trails. Overgrown plant removals from school campus.

Illinois Valley: Trail work on Upper Grayback and Forks Trails. Final salmon counts on Illinois River.

Kids Unlimited: Plant care for riparian project. Many salmon redds this year in the lower section of Bear Creek.

Myrtle Point: Continued garden work and tree lacing at high school and elementary school.

Pacific: Two 5 foot redwoods were planted and mulched at Elk River Hatchery. Brochure work and posts have begun on interpretive trail at Sixes River boat ramp.

South Medford: Saturday work on riparian restoration continues. Salmon counts have been completed. New bioswale is being created.
