### APRIL MONTHLY REPORT

April 30, 2020

We were able to deliver 17 scholarships of \$800 each to our five high schools. They can be used for college or vocational schools. Normal work continues on plant care on Jamberry Farm plus plant and garden maintenance at ongoing projects. We do have some students who have offered to help and we are keeping our physical distance when working together.

Butte Falls: Future hikes and garden work is on hold.

Coquille: Greenhouse cleanup, campus flower beds weeded in preparation for spring planting. A Believe You Can Achieve student is helping.

Gold Beach: Maintenance continues twice monthly on Elephant Bar and Rotary Trails, the hatchery grounds and campus garden. A Believe You Can Achieve student is helping.

Illinois Valley: Trail work on Grayback Trail.

Jamberry Farm: 14 varieties of native plants are cared for. They will be used 2020/2021 on Bear Creek.

Kids Unlimited: Riparian restoration and trash pickup.

Medford Parks: Weekly maintenance and trash pickup on 3 miles of Bear Creek.

Myrtle Point: Garden care at the high school and rose garden. A Believe You Can Achieve student is helping.

Pacific: Maintenance at Iron Head Boat Ramp and Crooked Fir Trail.

South Medford High School: Weekly maintenance continues on a 3 mile stretch of Bear Creek— weeding, mulching, watering, blackberry removal, and trash pickup. Two students are helping.
