### OCTOBER REPORT

November 1, 2020

Trail work, riparian planting, and salmon counts on Bear Creek have been our main focus in October. Students from all schools are excited to be back working on community service projects.

Butte Falls: Still waiting for fall field trips.

Coquille: Campus cleanup included blackberry and tall grass removal from the area around the greenhouse. Plants were dug and placed in the greenhouse to winter over.

Gold Beach: Students worked on on-campus gardens and assisted with cleanups at the hatchery, Rotary Trail, and Elephant Bar Trail.

Illinois Valley: Cleanups on Upper Grayback Trail and Forks State Park.

Jamberry Farm: Started planting native plants from farm to Bear Creek.

Kids Unlimited: Plant maintenance and salmon counts on Bear Creek below the Mahar building.

Medford Parks: Weekly maintenance on 4 miles of Bear Creek. Riparian planting and Bear Creek salmon counts, which were twice that of last year.

Myrtle Point: Garden and campus cleanups.

Pacific: Maintenance on Iron Head Boat Ramps, Crooked Fir Trail, and Elk River Hatchery grounds.

South Medford High School: Four seniors and 3 SMHS graduates have created another 300 feet of creek side trail and started planting native species plants
