APRIL MONTHLY REPORT

May 1, 2021

Watering, weeding, and fresh bark chips to native plants continues on Bear Creek. Coastal trails and gardens are being maintained.

Butte Falls: Planning for field trips next school year.

Coquille: On campus work included cutting weeds and tall grass around the greenhouse and hatchery and caring for begonia baskets by BYCA (Believe You Can Achieve) students.

Gold Beach: BYCA students worked on campus gardens. Work also continues on Panther and Elephant Bar Trails and the hatchery grounds.

Illinois Valley: Spring maintenance on Forks Park and Upper Grayback Trails. Both spots were very dry.

Jamberry Farm: Over 200 new seedlings have been planted and show good growth. We had 90% survival on our snowberry and black cottonwood cuttings.

Kids Unlimited: Maintenance work on stream bank. Removal of 2 campsites.

Medford Parks: Weekly trail pick up including abandoned campsites continues. Trail work, weeding and mulching native plants continues. Opened up riparian area below Bear Creek Park. High school and college students did the work.

Myrtle Point: Maintenance continues on the new rock garden at Myrtle Crest School.

Pacific: Work continued on Iron Head boat ramp, Elk River Hatchery and Crooked Fir Trail.

South Medford High School: Work continues on Bear Creek restoration project. Students from RCC and OSU worked with BYCA high school students.
